**ELECTION PROCEEDINGS TERMINATED DUE TO DEATH OF  
CONTESTING CANDIDATES**

**Islamabad, the 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2013.-** The Secretary, Election Commission of Pakistan has informed that due to death of contesting candidates of the following constituencies, the Returning Officers concerned have terminated the proceedings relating to elections from these constituencies by issuing Public Notice under section 18 of the Representation of the People Act, 1976.
